The fairy knew how poor and honest we were and how badly we want a child, so she's turned the piglet into a baby.

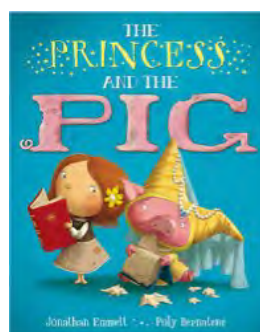
The fairy wasn't invited to the Princess's christening, so she's turned the baby into a piglet to get her revenge.
